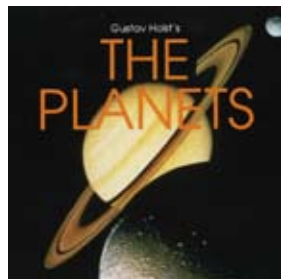


MASTERWORKS III

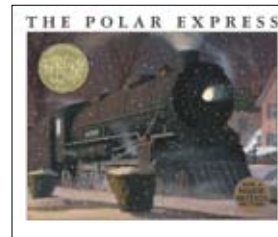

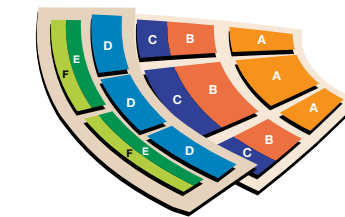
